
4. Mental Health and Well-being

Program Name: Annual Outreach Program

Program Name: APAF Artist Development Program

Program Duration: 3 Months

Objective: To provide comprehensive and accredited training to young individuals identified in the talent identification stage, equipping them with the skills, knowledge, and certification needed to excel in their chosen field within the performing arts and film industry.

Components:

- Structured, intensive 3-month training initiative aimed at nurturing and enhancing the artistic and technical skills of selected participants.
- Certification that acknowledges participants' proficiency and readiness to pursue professional opportunities in their chosen field.



Program Name: APAF Arts Capacity Building Program

Objective: To strengthen the capabilities of local artists and arts organizations.

Components:

- **Professional Development Workshops:** Workshops on topics such as arts management, marketing, and fundraising.
- **Networking Events:** Opportunities for artists and arts organizations to connect, collaborate, and share resources.

SUSTAINABILITY


